***I. Review of the December 11, 2017 minutes:***

***II. Formulary Review***

Ms.Keller submitted a recommendation to the committee on the new proposed categories per Facts & Comparisons. This list would update the formulary to reflect the current categories in Facts & Comparison and be in an alphabetical order. This would remove drugs that are no longer available on the market.

The committee reviewed the following new drugs to the market, as listed in Facts and Comparison, and recommended the following categories for these medications.

Emflaza was brought back to the Committee as the PA/Scope of practice committee felt that it should be in the PI category instead of the CTP may prescribe category as recommended by the PAPC in December. The committee agreed and moved it to the PI category.

Mr. Cackler moved to approve this change. Dr. Engle seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

Bevyxxa was brought back to the Committee as the PA/Scope of practice committee felt that only anticoagulants should move to the may prescribe. It was determined that oral the Xa inhibitor was meant to be put in the may prescribe not the entire anticoagulant category. No change was made from the December recommendation.

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Vabomere added to formulary as PI.

Dr. Steinbergh moved to approve this change. Dr. Engle seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

Mavyret added to formulary as PI.

Mr. Cackler moved to approve this change. Dr. Engle seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

Aliqopa, Calquence, Idihifa and Verzenio were all added to the formulary as CTP may not prescribe.

Dr. Engle moved to approve this change. Ms. Thurman seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

Benznidazole was added to formulary as PI

Dr. Engle moved to approve this change. Mr. Cox seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

Solosec was put in the CTP may prescribe category

Dr. Engle moved to approve this change. Mr. Cackler seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

Respiratory tract agents are an ongoing discussion.

### ***III. Review Formulary request form***

It was recommended that the form asks for the current FDA label and that the form revised date be added.

Dr. Steinbergh moved to approve the form as amended. Mr. Cackler seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.
