I. Review of the February 12, 2018 minutes:

Mr. Cackler moved to approve the minutes. Dr. Engle seconded the motion.

II. Formulary Review

The committee then reviewed the new drugs to the market for February 2018 as follows:

Lutathera. Placed under "Antineoplastic" as a new category of "Radiopharmaceutical (Lutetium)" as May NOT prescribe.

Dr. Steinbergh moved to approve this change. Dr. Engle seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

The committee recommended moving all corticosteroids under the respiratory tract agent section as CTP May Prescribe.

Mr. Cackler moved to approve this change. Dr. Steinbergh seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

Dr. Engle recommended that all controlled substances include the language "DEA registration required" so that we are consistent.

Dr. Steinbergh moved to approve this change. Mr. Cackler seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

It was requested that a pharmacist prepare a listing of all antivirals and antifungals on the formulary for review in April.

III. Review rules

Ms. Debolt presented rules 4730-1-05, 4730-2-04, and 4730-2-05 to the committee and stated that there were minor changes as a result of the interested party comments.

Dr. Steinbergh moved to send the amended rules to CSI for processing. Mr. Cackler seconded the motion. All members voted aye. The motion carried.

The Physician Assistant Policy Committee meeting was adjourned by Dr. Gingrich at approximately 9:17a.m. on Monday March 12, 2018.
