# Exam Changes

# Examination

*Effective March 30, 2020*

Applicants must first pass the Certified Clinical Electrologist Examination (CCE) taken through the Society for Clinical & Medical Hair Removal.



# Examination



The Medical Board will administer the limited branch portions of the cosmetic therapy exam on December 2, 2019.

Applications must be received **before 5 p.m. on November 18, 2019.**



# Licensure and Renewal Changes

# License Approval Changes

*Effective October 17, 2019*



Law changes **eliminate** statutory requirement for at least six affirmative votes by board members to issue a license

- Medical Board adopted management rule to implement this change effective 10-17-2019

Enables Deputy Director of Licensure to issue licenses faster and more often than once a month.

# Board Actions

*Effective October 17, 2019*



The board can impose terms and conditions to ensure an applicant's fitness to practice.

The board can impose a civil penalty up to \$5,000 if the CCTE requirements are not met.




All licenses issued prior to October 17 will continue to use the existing renewal schedule based on last name.

# Continuing Education

Amendments to Rule 4731-1-08 in the Ohio Administrative Code reduced the amount of required CCTE from 25 hours to 12 hours every two years.





# **Confidential Monitoring Programs**

# One-bite Program



One-bite Program is a confidential program for the treatment of impaired licensees of the Medical Board - established in section [4731.251](#) of the Revised Code

It makes recovery a non-disciplinary program for initial incidents and self-reported impairment by licensees

To participate, licensees must meet all three requirements:

1. Diagnosed with substance use disorder and impaired in inability to practice
2. First time participant in the program
3. No prior disciplinary action for substance use disorder or impairment by any licensing board in Ohio

# Confidential Monitoring Program

*Mental or physical condition impacting ability to practice*



Board Secretary & Supervising Member oversee agency investigation and enforcement processes

Secretary & Supervising Member may determine that an individual being investigated concerning a mental or physical illness, is appropriate for ongoing investigative observation and monitoring by the board rather than formal public disciplinary action

Licensee signs a confidential participation agreement with the board

# Confidential Monitoring Program

*Mental or physical condition impacting ability to practice*



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
Eligibility as determined by Board Secretary and Supervising Member

Cooperate with investigation
Undertake treatment if required
Adhere to treatment plan – take meds
No sexual boundary issues
No past or current threats of violence or acts of violence against property or individuals

No criminal conduct or convictions
No other basis for action by board
Not currently on probation with board
No information indicating that allowing confidential monitoring creates risk of potential patient harm
